Executive Summary:

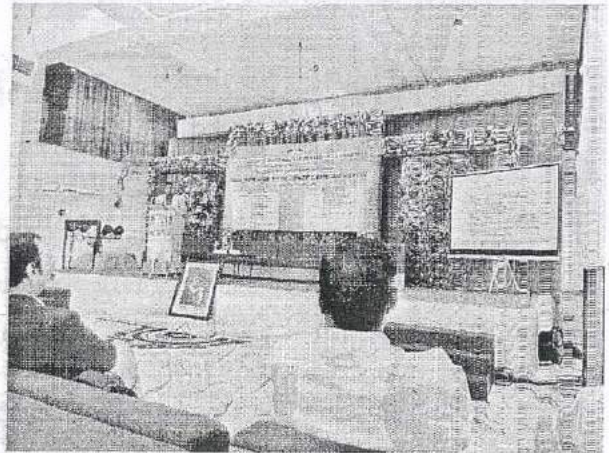

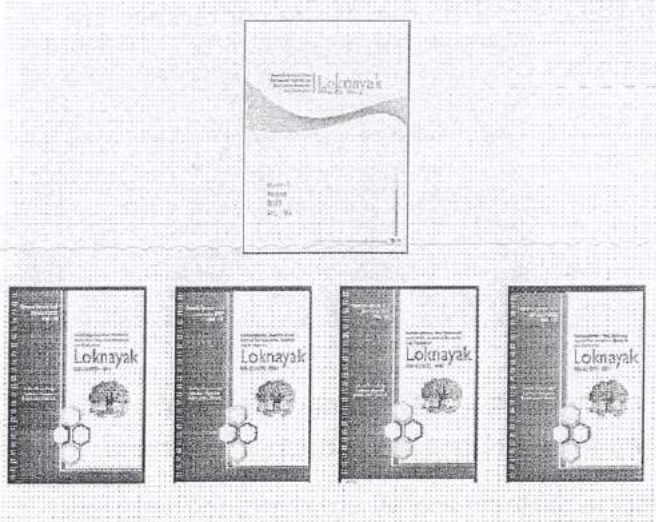
Publication

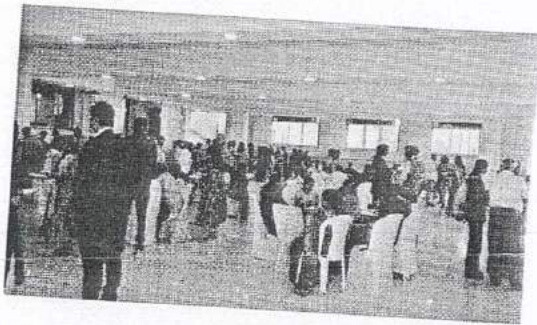
